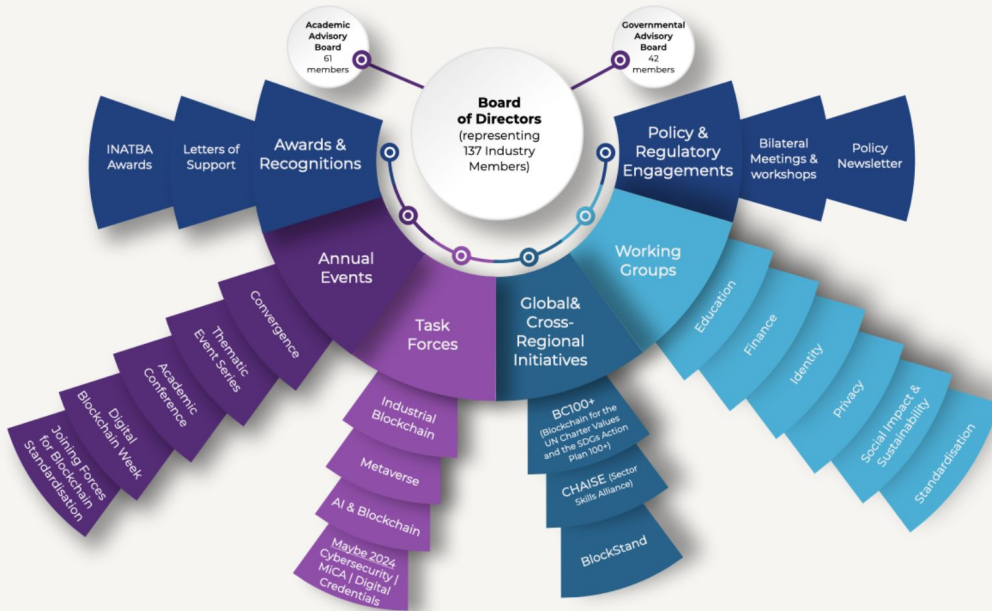

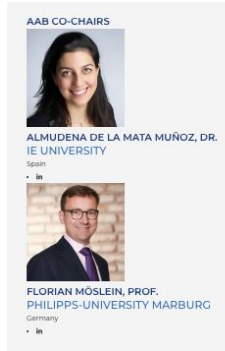

**Highlights: Worldwide Developments**

In late January, China announced an upcoming incident in its Crypto risk regulation. The State Information Security Administration (SISA) and the Ministry of Industry and Information Technology (MIIT) issued a joint statement regarding the incident. The report reveals the incident was a security vulnerability, but the risk for identity.
