Incubation Entry Considerations

Maintainers

- Code should exist as open source software in some form
 - ✓ All repos are open source in [Hyperledger Labs](#)
- DCO sign off should exist in the code repository
 - ✓ All repos have automatic DCO enforcement
- The project should have multiple maintainers
 - ✓ All repos have at least 3 maintainers (see MAINTAINERS.MD in each repo)

Maintainers

- The project should have demonstrable examples of POC/production uses publicly available
 - ✔ Several POCs have been publicly discussed on community calls
 - [Giving Chain](#)
 - [Financial POC](#)
- The project should have the backing of more than one organization/individuals
 - ✔ Developers (non-maintainers) are actively contributing code

Community

- Contributors familiar with open source practices
 - ✔ Project maintainers are familiar with open source practices and have documented the contribution process for newcomers

Sponsors

- There should be more than one sponsor, and they should be from different organizations
- ✓ There are 13 sponsors from 9 organizations in the original [project proposal document](#)

Legal

- Project names should not be trademarked by a contributing company
 - ✓ FireFly is not a Kaleido (contributing company) copyright
- Codebase should be Apache 2 licensable, without encumbrances
 - ✓ Codebase is licensed under Apache 2
- If code does not already have copyright, the code should be modified to include copyright
 - ✓ Codebase is licensed under Apache 2

Overlap with Existing Projects

- Not another distributed ledger project
 - ✓ FireFly is a layer above the distributed ledger itself
- New projects should bring something to the table that current projects do not
 - ✓ FireFly fills a real gap in the enterprise blockchain space. FireFly maintainers and Fabric Smart Client maintainers both agreed that the projects do not overlap.

Community Milestones

Community Milestones (since June 2021)

- Kickoff at Hyperledger Global Forum
- 3 Meetups across North America, APAC, India
- 10 Community calls
- 119,000 lines of code - additional 44k lines of code since launch!
