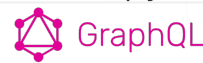

- › Founded in summer of 2020, LF Public Health's mission is to curate and support open source software to help public health authorities (PHAs) and healthcare delivery around the world.
- › The initial focus of LFPH has been helping PHAs deploy an app implementing the Google Apple Exposure Notification (GAEN) system.
- › We are moving into other areas of digital health that can take advantage of open source innovation, and collaboration with Open Source Program Offices (OSPOs) in health agencies.

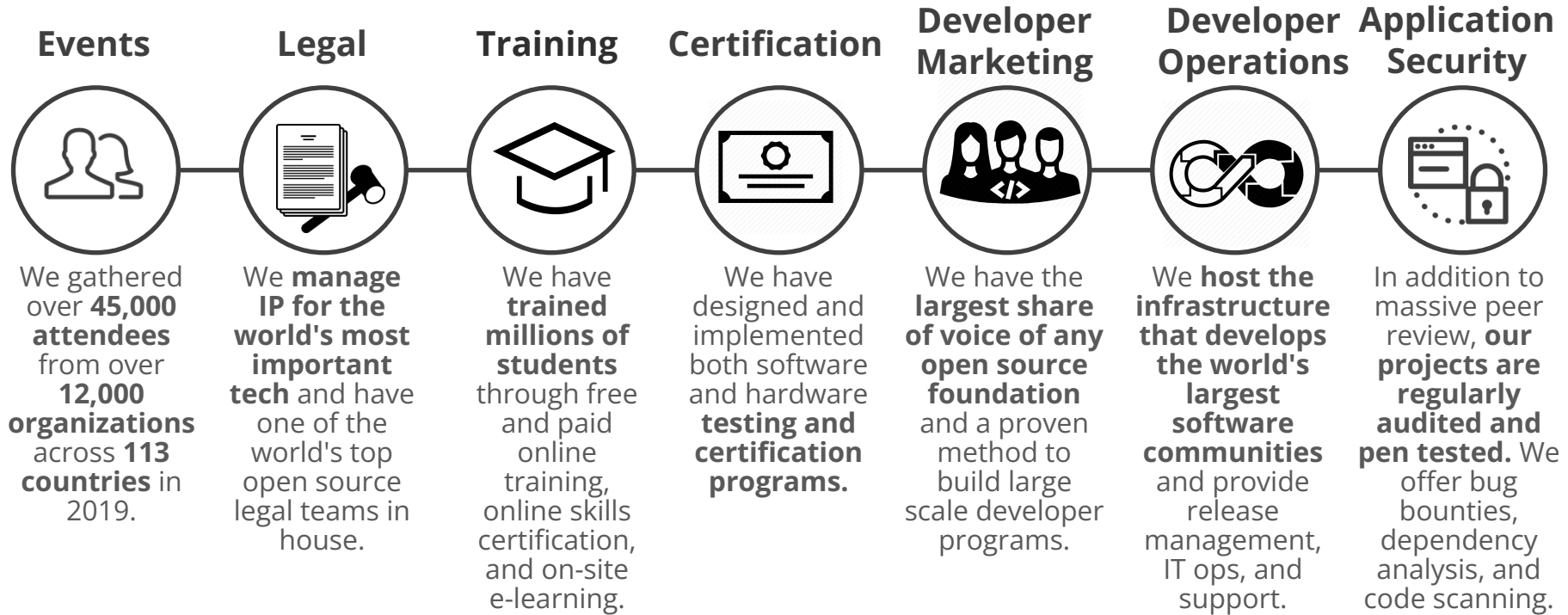
