

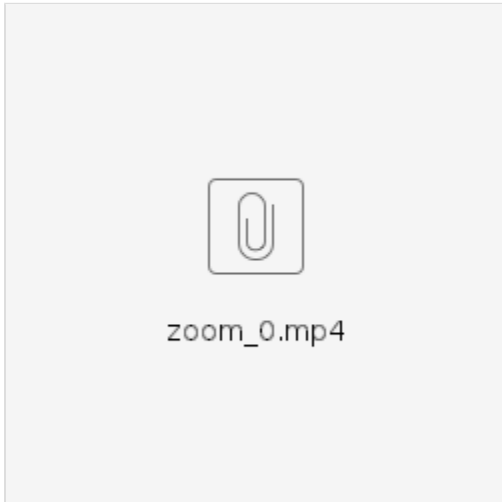
Standards WG - Meeting May 11
