Dr. Ali Emdad is the Associate Dean of the *Earl G. Graves School of Business and Management* at *Morgan State University* in Baltimore, Maryland. He oversees all daily operations in the *Graves School* and assists the Dean in setting the vision and strategic priorities for the School. He is the Founding Director of the *Center for the Study of Blockchain and Financial Technology* (The FinTech Center) where he manages a multi-year, multi-million dollar grant received from Ripple in February 2019. Previously, he served as the Founding Chair of the *Department of Information Science and Systems* in the *Graves School* where he holds rank of Full Professor with tenure.
